

## About Fassnidge Park

Fassnidge Park was once part of the extensive gardens of The Cedars, an 18th century townhouse in Uxbridge High Street. Kate and Sidney Fassnidge lived in the townhouse, which had been in the Fassnidge family for over a century.

Upon Sidney's death in 1921, Kate Fassnidge donated six acres of the gardens and land next to the Frays River to Uxbridge District Council. She

requested that it be turned into a public park in Sidney's memory 'for the quiet enjoyment and pleasure of its townspeople'. She also stipulated that the park be 'for public use and no other, to be free of charge at all times'.

Fassnidge Park (originally called The Fassnidge Memorial Recreation Ground) was designed by William Lionel Eves and opened in October 1926.
